



Parkview Neighbourhood Garden is seeking volunteer musicians to perform during sales days and special events. Our garden operates from May to October each year.

We are located at 44 Parkview Ave., North York. Close to Yonge Street and Empress Avenue.

The goal of the garden's music program is to bring more community members into the garden, to make the garden a relaxing space for gardeners and non-gardeners alike, and provide performance experience for musicians. Volunteers will perform for 5-20 minute intervals, with breaks. More than one musician may be featured at each event.

We are an organic market garden, volunteer-run and operated, guided by a leadership team. We garden and make decisions as a group; we do not have individual allotments. We aim to provide an enjoyable, safe place to grow crops, to teach and learn the techniques of successful sustainable gardening, and to gather as friends. We sell our produce to the community from a cart in the garden, donate a portion of the revenue to charity and use the remainder to buy seeds and supplies. We also donate produce to the local food bank and to shut-ins.
